Winning Technologies to Host Open House in Little Elm

September 1 Event Features Tours of Winning's Mobile Command Center

THE TOWN OF LITTLE ELM, TX -- August 18, 2006 -- Winning Technologies, a nationwide information technology consulting firm with offices in Texas, will host a ribbon cutting and open house, 9am to 11am, Friday, September 1, 2006 at the Town of Little Elm City Hall. The event will be held in conjunction with the Little Elm Chamber of Commerce and will feature a special appearance and tours of Winning Technologies' mobile command center. Everyone is welcome to attend.

Winning Technologies developed the mobile command center to help government, federal and local agencies, and other organizations with high-tech, on-site communications during times of emergencies and natural disasters. The unit is 45 feet long and 8.5 feet wide. It has a hitch compatible with Goose Neck trailers and 5th wheels for ease of transportation across town or across the nation.

Communication features include a working satellite for data communications, two VoIP phones, two computer workstations, a Hamm radio, a White Board, a printer, a scanner and copier. The unit also includes a full sleeping area, a microwave oven, a generator, a refrigerator, chairs and a conference area. It is heated and air-conditioned.

The command center is capable of hosting 175 persons as a first aid station. It has a 10-foot by 20-foot external canopy, a 24-foot ladder, 155 hand tools, and a water cooler and picnic table. Included is a heavy-duty bumper hitch with a 40-gallon external fuel tank.

Scott Lewis, president of Winning Technologies, said the mobile command center was developed as a result of the Hurricane Katrina and Rita disasters. "Everyone witnessed the communication challenges various agencies had during the aftermath of the hurricanes in the Gulf Coast. We wanted to be able to contribute so those kinds of problems can be reduced if not eliminated in the future. The mobile command center serves that purpose with state-of-the-art communications. It stands ready for any emergency or for use by any credible agency or organization."
